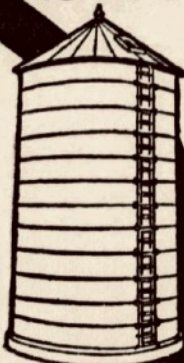

BOOSTING GOOD ROADS.

Through C. L. Morris, its president, the Washington State Good Roads Association is fostering a movement to bring D. Ward King, known throughout the highway world as the originator and inventor of the King Split-log drag, to the state of Washington to deliver a series of lectures and demonstrate the King drag system of maintenance for earth and gravel roads.

The association believes Mr. King will arouse sufficient interest here, as he has in other states, to bring about well-nigh state-wide use of the drag. Mr. King has achieved fame as a demonstrator and lecturer, and his success in popularizing the drag has been nothing short of marvelous. In Missouri, for instance, as a result of King's lectures, thousands of miles of unspeakably bad earth roads have been developed into fine highways, and properly maintained through the use of the King drag. And the expense per mile averaged about \$15 a year.

Acting upon the suggestion of President Morris, the Automobile Club of Seattle has agreed to finance one of these lectures, and in addition has donated a sufficient sum to take care of the expense of arranging for the series of lectures which the association hopes to have held in at least ten of the larger cities of the state. It is the association's aim to have Mr. King deliver a lecture in Spokane, Walla Walla, North Yakima, Colfax, Wenatchee, Vancouver, Chehalis, Aberdeen, Hoquiam, Raymond, Tacoma, Everett, Centralia, Bellingham, Port Townsend, Renton, Seattle, Snohomish, Kent, Auburn, Puyallup, Olympia, Issaquah, Monroe, Mount Vernon, Sedro-Woolley and Blain.

To carry on an active campaign to this end, the association has sent S. P. Davis Washington's King-split-log drag expert, on a tour of the state. "King" Davis will carry credentials from President Morris, and a letter urging the various communities to get in line and help educate the people about road maintenance, one of the most important features of the highway movement.

The movement to bring King to Washington is in keeping with resolutions adopted at the last annual convention of the Washington State Good Roads' Association in North Yakima, which voted to urge the legislature to enact a compulsory drag law. King's lectures and the drag contests inaugurated by him, are expected to pave the way for this law.

LABOR AND GRANGE MEASURES.

Seven initiative bills, carrying out the program of the State Grange, State Federation of Labor and Farmers' Union, endeavored to put through the last legislature but failed, will be filed with the secretary of state by C. B. Kegley of Palouse, master of the Washington State Grange, in Olympia this week making final arrangements for the purpose.

The bills are:
1. "Blue sky" law—Regulating the formation of corporations, preventing imposition and fraud in the sale of stocks and bonds and land, and regulating corporations engaged in selling such articles.
2. "Anti-pork-barrel" road law—

Establishing a state highway fund with an annual fixed levy of one-half mill, and placing the administration under the state highway engineer; taking from the legislature the power of appropriating money for road work; authorizing the employment of convicts from the penitentiary or reformatory upon state highways; permitting the sentencing of convicts to public highway work and not to

the penitentiary; granting convicts employment for at least thirty days after their release at a reasonable wage which may be paid to them or their dependent families, and providing for the payment to dependent families of convicts engaged in road work not to exceed 50 cents a day.

3. First-aid bill—Providing first aid for employees injured while working in extra-hazardous industries, a change in the industrial insurance law for which the State Federation of Labor has been working since the establishment of the commission.

4. Preventing employment agencies receiving any fees or remuneration, direct or indirect, for securing employment for anyone.

5. Fish revenue bill—Repealing "secret clause" which prohibits state fish commissioner giving information relative to that industry in this state upon penalty of \$1,000 fine; compelling fishing at least once each year in fishtrap locations instead of once every four years; fixing a royalty on all fish taken from waters in this state for commercial purposes, so that the

state will receive a revenue and not face a deficit in handling this industry.

6 and 7. Abolishing and consolidating boards and commissions; abolishing the tax commission and consolidating it with the public service commission; abolishing the state board of inspection and supervision of public offices and the state board of accountancy and vesting their powers and duties in the state auditor; providing for uniform public accountancy and the employment of three competent accountants at a salary not exceeding \$1,800 a year and necessary traveling expenses.

WALLA WALLA, Wash., Feb. 2.—Byron Hunter today took up his work as Washington State Agriculturist under the direction of the Department of Agriculture. Mr. Hunter has been district agriculturist for the government, covering territory embraced by Washington, Oregon and Idaho.
