When you sign up for a membership and add the \$10. one year subscription to the on-line newspaper archives you will receive a **coupon code that gives you a Premium account** with Small Town Newspapers, (STP) the platform that hosts our digitized newspaper issues.

The current archives have 21 years of searchable papers from 1948 to 1989. That is 1079 weekly editions containing 16129 pages.

Included in the Premium account:

- A one click jumbo viewer that enlarges the page you are viewing
- Search function with bright highlighting of the search term
- Download pages as a JPEG or PDF
- Save pages to a "scrapbook" folder, you can set up as many scrapbook folders as you may need
- There are no annoying pop up messages asking you to upgrade your account..

Plus access to newspapers in other towns and states including 81 newspapers in Washington State, 20 in Oregon, 18 in Idaho and over 400 more from every state in America.

Example:

Become an Individual member for \$10. and for another \$10. you get on-line newspaper access for that membership year.

A Small Town Newspaper subscription is \$60. a year.
